Additional activities include **yarn wrapping** with ReCreative resident artist <u>Kim Mirus</u>, **Fabric Feels: Scraps + Stories** with <u>betterish</u>, a **costume display** and a TBD activity with Denver refugee non-profit <u>We Made This</u>.

The *ReDefine* series topics are chosen based on materials ReCreative Denver sees donated most frequently in order to showcase their wide range of uses and to inspire people to engage in creative reuse in their own lives. Each *ReDefine* event begins with an open-to-the-public brainstorm to ensure the event has buy-in and participation from ReCreative's diverse community. The *ReDefine* series was launched in November 2018 with *ReDefine: WOOD* and continued with *ReDefine: PAPER*, which received coverage from 303 Magazine, Westword and Do303.
